

## Pomperaug District Department of Health Policy for Administering Flu Vaccine When Children Accompanied by Persons Other Than Parent

The Pomperaug District Department of Health will not administer flu vaccine to children under the age of 18 unless they are accompanied by a parent/legal guardian or a caregiver with the following permission letter.

Note to parents from the Pomperaug District Department of Health:

- FluMist nasal spray vaccine is not available.
- We define a caregiver as: grandparent, sibling older than 18 years, or a nanny.
- Consent forms for children over three years are available at <u>www.pddh.org</u>. We would prefer that parents fill out and sign the consent form and have the caregiver bring it to the clinic along with this form. Consent forms for children 6 months through 2 years are available only at the clinic.
