

## Pomperaug District Department of Health Policy for Administering Flu Vaccine When Children Accompanied by Persons Other Than Parent

The Pomperaug District Department of Health will not administer flu vaccine to children under the age of 18 unless they are accompanied by a parent/legal guardian or a caregiver with the following permission letter.

Note to parents from the Pomperaug District Department of Health:

- Please complete one form per child
- Caregiver must be 18 years or older.
- Consent forms are available at <u>www.pddh.org</u>. We would prefer that parents fill out and sign the consent form and have the caregiver bring it to the clinic along with this form.
- Caregiver must present the child's insurance card. A copy would also be acceptable.
